I AM A FOURTH-GENERATION STUDENT at Adams State. Not only did my father and grandfather graduate from Adams, but so did my great-grandfather, Hartley Owsley. Since 1936, the Owsley family has supported this institution through devoted involvement with the Alumni Association, presidential search committees, the Grizzly Club, and much more.

I am very proud to say that because of my family's involvement, my dedication in high school, and my upbringing here in the Valley, I am able to go to Adams State University for my first year for virtually no cost. Receiving scholarships such as the Alamosa State Bank – Clyde Helms Memorial Scholar-

ship and the Alumni Foundation Scholarship has blessed me more than I imagined. They allow me to focus on my studies, instead of stressing about how I will pay for my education. I admit filling out the applications was a little stressful, but it was truly worth it.

Last February, during my senior year of high school, I spent almost every night in the Adams State library working on scholarship applications. At first Adams State was only my back-up plan, but after I saw my hard work pay off and began to receive scholarships, I knew that it was the right choice for me.

Another deciding factor in choosing Adams was my ability to easily transfer my 28 concurrent credits from high school. This has allowed me to focus on my double major in accounting and finance; I plan to complete my associate's degree by the end of the summer. That means I'll graduate a year early with the class of 2018 and get a head start on my goals. These include joining the Peace Corps and teaching economic development, getting my CPA certification, and one day starting my own small business in the Valley. All of these goals are more doable when faced with little to no student debt.

I am especially appreciative of these scholarships because I never expected I would be one of those people with enough scholarships to pay for my education. I was never the smartest kid in my class, and my family's financial need according to FASEA was never too high. I just cannot thank the ASU Foundation enough for recognizing my dedication to improve academically and reach my potential as a student.

I am proud to say I finished my first semester at Adams State with a 4.0. I wouldn't have been able to do it without the support of the ASU Foundation and generous donors like you. Remember, when you give to Adams State, you help students like me.

SPECIAL EVENTS

\$15,000 WOMEN'S WEEK

Each spring, Women's Week offers events such as films, speakers, presentations, and panels that address women's and gender issues.

\$6,000 THEATRE PROGRAM HOLIDAY SHOW

The Theatre Program's annual holiday show appeals to families of the San Luis Valley. Several matinee performances are attended exclusively by public school children. For many, it might be the only affordable, quality, theatrical performance they will see. The show traditionally has a very large cast, but large casts mean large costume budgets, and productions for children mean large spectacle costs. Thus, continuation of this holiday tradition requires sponsorship.

\$3,000 EARTH WEEK 2016 SPEAKER: "GETTING GREEN DONE"

Auden Schendler, VP of Sustainability at Aspen Ski Company, will relate company profits to greening and show how to make a big impact at your own organization/company.

\$2,000 LUNCHTIME TALKS IN SCIENCE & MATHEMATICS

Now in its 12th year, this free, general interest lecture series showcases faculty from across campus, as well as outside speakers. Free pizza lunch is provided at every talk.

VISITING ARTISTS & MUSICIANS

\$3,000 VISITING MUSICAL ARTISTS, CLINICIANS & COMPOSERS

Host nationally recognized musicians, composers, and clinicians for performances, master classes, and forums.

\$2,000 ARTIST IN RESIDENCE

An ongoing Artist In Residence Program to allow the Art Department to host a national/international artist for 1-3 weeks each year or semester.

ACADEMIC OUTREACH

\$5,000 RAGING STUDIOS

The "Raging Studios" project is an official research project that examines songs, lyrics, and poetry written with the intention of channeling voluntary/involuntary minority rage, which may be based on inequity of people with different backgrounds, socio-economic status, race, ethnicity, gender, and sexual orientation. It has cultivated high-quality work in the field of inclusive excellence involving faculty, staff, students, and alumni who would otherwise not have had a chance to record in a professional studio. Funding will continue this project.

\$5,000 PLANETARIUM PROGRAMMING

Funding to expand the Zacheis Planetarium's library of programs for outreach to school groups, scouts, Boys & Girls Club, SLV Behavioral Health Group, assisted living and veterans centers, as well as the general public.

\$500 STUDENT & FACULTY MUSIC ENSEMBLE EDUCATIONAL PERFORMANCE/WORKSHOP IN AREA & REGIONAL SCHOOLS

Allow chamber student ensembles and faculty to continue performing and leading educational workshops in the K-12 schools.

CONFERENCES & TRAVEL

\$100,000 ART TRAVEL FUND

Fund annual student trips to major national art institutions.

\$15,000 WESTERN SLOPE UNDERGRADUATE SOCIOLOGY CONFERENCE

Allow sociology students to present original research projects for discussion and critique at the conference, which rotates among four institutions.

\$5,000 MUSIC EDUCATION CONFERENCES & COMPETITIONS

Allows students to continue participating in the conferences and competitions of these nationally recognized professional organizations such as the Colorado Music Educators Association (CMEA), American Choral Directors Association, NATS (National Association of Teachers of Singing), and PASIC (Percussive Arts Society International Convention).

\$3,000 ANNUAL ONE-DAY MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL ENGLISH TEACHERS' CONFERENCE

Beginning in April 2016, this one-day spring conference invites middle and high school English teachers to present on best practices in pedagogy, bring students to present their best papers, and allows current ASU teacher-candidates to network with current practitioners. It will also promote recruitment into the forthcoming MA in Humanities / English emphasis and undergraduate programs.

SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENTS

\$50,000 ART SCHOLARSHIP

Art scholarship fund for either graduate or undergraduate students.

\$40,000 CHAMBER MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Renewable scholarships for student chamber ensembles, both instrumental and vocal, will make Adams State more competitive in student recruitment. Ensembles would include, but not be limited to, a woodwind quintet, brass quintet, string quartet, percussion quartet, vocal quartet, jazz ensemble, drum line, etc.

\$10,000 ENDOWED NAMED MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Provide merit- or need-based scholarships for music students.

CAMPUS IMPROVEMENTS

\$1,000 - \$20,000 REPLACE HAZARD TREES

Replacement of 20 campus trees that have been removed due to safety hazards. (\$1,000/tree)

\$15,000 C.A.S.A. CENTER (CULTURAL AWARENESS & STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT) BACKYARD ENHANCEMENT

Create seven flagstone picnic tables with flagstone bench seating in the C.A.S.A. backyard, as well as one 12-foot flagstone labor/picnic table for food service during event programming. These will provide additional space for the growing number of student, faculty, staff, and community attendees at Soul Food Friday Luncheons and Hispanic Heritage events.

\$5,000 ART EQUIPMENT

A significant piece of equipment such as a kiln or laser cutter.

\$3,210 NEW FURNISHINGS THE LOFT - SUB

Replace worn/damaged sofas in the Loft (Student Union Building). The space serves both students and community guests.

\$3,000 PRODUCTION EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE

Production equipment in the Haynie Center for Mass Communication requires upgraded and expanded cabinetry to organize all equipment resources within long-lasting, protective cases. This organization process would ensure that high-priced equipment reaches its maximum potential.

FOUNDATION MATCHES GRANT FOR STUDENT DOCUMENTARY PRODUCTION

The ASU Foundation matched a \$5,000 grant from the Colorado Office of Film, TV and Media to fund a project by students in "Documentary Film Production," taught by Paul Echeverria, asst. professor of mass communications. The resulting film, due to be completed by the fall, will air on Rocky Mountain PBS.

Connections made through ASU Community Partnerships led to receipt of the grant, which will cover production and travel costs.

The 15 students in Echeverria's class first identified two subjects, the San Luis Valley and technology, and then each created a treatment relating to one of those narratives. Their final topic is "The Silent Crisis," which will explore food insecurity in the San Luis Valley. Production will take place during April and May.

"They are working from an idea into telling a story in an actual film that will go in-depth with the subject," Echeverria explained. "This project is exciting, as is the potential for more collaboration with the film office in Denver."
